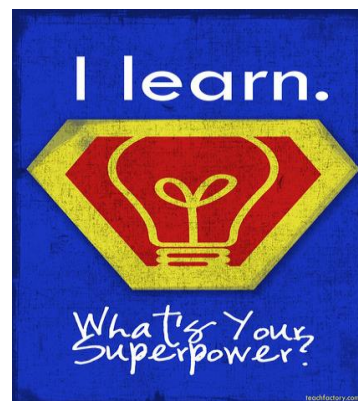

Students will be asked, "what is your super power"? Students get to come to school dressed up and show off their 'super power' at the assembly.

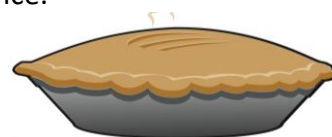


## BAKED GOODS FUNDRAISER
