REMINDER ABOUT ABSENCES FROM SCHOOL

If your child is absent for any reason, we would appreciate either a text via our SMS, phone call or hand written note to the school with a reason why they are away. It is a legal requirement not only by the school but also by yourselves as parents/carers to keep the school informed as to why your child/children are not at school.

BUS INFORMATION

The school office has been receiving a high volume of calls from Buswest that parents/carers are not home for their children at drop off time. The procedure at home time is ...

If you are not home the first time the bus stops, we will receive a call from Buswest to say no one is home. The bus will continue their route and in the meantime the school will try to contact you to find out where you are or how far away you are from being home. The bus will finish their run and go back to your home a second time and if you are still not home they will bring your child/ren back to school and you will have to make arrangements to pick them up.

Keep in mind that the office closes at 4:00pm so we expect that your child/ren get picked up as soon as possible. If you know you are not going to be home in the afternoon, please call the school and we can make sure your child/ren don't board the bus and you can pick them up at the office.
